MISSION To remove everyday hazardous materials and chemicals from around town and dispose of them safely (urban collection only)

The Dannevirke Host Lions will be operating a Free Drop-Off Centre at 40 Denmark Street (down driveway between Elders and Dorrington Poole & Partners) where you can leave any unwanted Hazards for safe disposal - Look for the Lions Sign.

If you are unable to make it to the drop off point because of ill health, disability or lack of transport, a member from Lions can come to you.

**Used Oils * Car Batteries * Paints & Solvents * Weed Killers
* Garden Chemicals/Sprays * Household Cleaners
* Liquid/Dry Chemicals * Gas Cylinders**

- If you have chemicals of any kind that are not safe for transport, i.e. leaking from the container - Phone the Hazard Helpline (see over for details)
- If you don't have transport or you are ill or disabled, call us and we will arrange for Lions to collect from your property.

IF IT LEAKS - LEAVE IT

- If it's leaking or you're unsure about what it is called, phone the Hazard Helpline number and we will arrange to collect it.
